BREXIT-EU, Trade & India

Three basic elements matter in driving growth: People, Institutions and Polity. Recent introduction of exit of UK from euro countries is a matter of concern and choice. It is a concern because people are not sure of what next although they are driven by political compulsions. The choice is always influenced by external forces which create optimism. The collective decision of people in voting to exit from European Union (EU) created many triggers. The first causality of BREXIT is reflected in continuous increase in price of gold. The investors are moving toward safer assets. The shift from stocks and securities to yellow metal is an indication of change in collective behaviour of investors. The increase in gold price at international and in domestic markets has led to decline in the import of gold since last several weeks. The pound- sterling, euro and dollar currencies are on the verge of pre-setting the equations at foreign exchange market. The central banks of respective countries have been working hard to restore equilib-

rium level. Federal banks of these countries are aiming to develop a scenario to visualize short and long term implications. BREXIT has created tremors in the process of wealth creation. Marketing institutions are gearing up for managing projected instability at the supply and the demand levels.

There is dichotomy in the polity of Britain on this issue. The political equation in Asia and in American countries are experiencing a change to counter BREXIT effect. The quality of governance in terms of taking right steps, movements at the right time matters the most! The best proxy for good governance is quality leadership. The political leaders in these respective countries are making positive, proactive and precautionary statements to enable people participate in exchange transactions. The symposium on the theme at MPBIM will attempt to answer several questions.


INSPIRO 2K16- Intra Management Fest & Alumni Meet




