Vanamahotsava 2016

Vanamahotsava, a movement towards sustaining the environment by preserving greenery, was initiated in 1950 by Kulpati Dr. K.M.Munshi, the then Union Minster for Agriculture and Food to create enthusiasm among masses for forest conservation and planting trees. It was apt that Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's MPBIM, celebrate this environmental visionary's birthday by symbolic Vanamahotsava 'Plant a Sapling, Save the Planet' initiative on 30th December '16. Inaugurating the event Dr. B.N. The New Tax Regime in India

The passing of The Constitution (One Hundred and First Amendment) Act, 2016 on August 8, 2016 marked an era of 'one tax' regime of indirect taxes in India.

The Act will be implemented by Goods & Services Council headed by the Union Finance Minister as its Chairman, ex-officio. The tax has subsumed many taxes such as excise duty, additional customs duty, services tax surcharge & state level value added tax. On March 29, 2017, four bills were passed as Acts to be in effect from July1, 2017. The bills are: 1. Central Goods & Services Tax (GST); 2. Integrated Goods & Services Tax; 3. Goods & Services Tax (compensation to States) and 4. Union Territory Goods & Services Tax. The implementation of GST is aimed at rationalization of tax regime by avoiding duplication or overlapping of taxes which created burden directly on the manufacturer & indirectly on the consumer. At present, Petroleum & Petroleum Products are going to be affected. This will be followed by products of 'Business to Business' flow. The Union Government is aiming at better tax Governance both at the Centre and in the States. The guestion mur-

mured about is: How could a Government achieve its objective of welfare when corruption is at its zenith? How could a Government reach set targets when the budgeted amount is not fully utilized? Some skeptics argue on the funding to be received from the United Nations after implementation of the GST. No Government is obliged to set objectives drawn from outside its National Boundaries. However, it is imperative to consider new taxation system to enable the Government to perform for overall welfare. The quality of governance holds the key. Will our leadership rise to this occasion of reconstruction of India by effective governance of local institutions like Pani Samitis, Self Help Groups, Network Groups & such others? The skills in effective implementation will decide.




Sports Week at MPBIM
