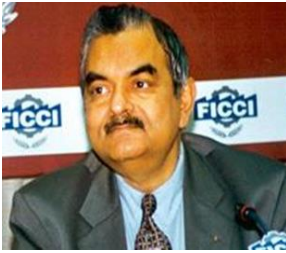


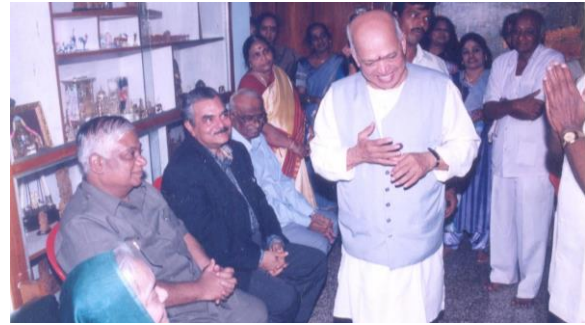
Sri. Rajendra Singh Lodha



Rajendra Singh Lodha (1942- 2008), popularly known as **R. S. Lodha**, was an Indian Chartered Accountant and the chairman of the Birla Corporation.

Sri. Rajendra S. Lodha has become the President-elect of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) in 2001. He assumed the office at the conclusion of the chamber's 74th annual session.

Sri. R S Lodha was a senior partner of accounting and consulting firm, Lodha & Co, which is the Indian member firm of BDO International. Besides, he was the Chairman of Alfred Herbert (India) Ltd and co-Chairman of Birla Corporation Ltd. A close confidante of Smt. Priyamvada Devi Birla, he took keen interest in M.P. Birla Foundation and institutions like MPBIFR, BIAPS and MPBIM.



In July 2004, Mrs. Priyamvada Birla, chairperson of the Birla Corporation, bequeathed the entire assets of the company to Lodha. Lodha subsequently took charge as Chairman of the Corporation.

Lodha died in [London](#) of an heart attack on October 3, 2008. He has two sons, Harshvardhan Lodha and Aditya Lodha and a daughter Meenakshi. Sri. Harshavardhan Lodha is now the Chairman of Birla Corporation.
